Guide to Applying for Your CCW in Kern County



Before You Apply, You Must Be:

- United States Citizen
- 21 Years or Older
- Not on any form of Probation
- No Felony Convictions
- If you have an arrest or conviction within the last five (5) years, you are generally disqualified.

Easy, Six Step Process

Gather Your Required Documents. These are the only proofs of residence will be accepted by the Sheriff's Office.

- a. Valid California Driver's License (address must be current)
- b. Two (2) Proofs of Residence:
 - i. DMV Vehicle Registration (Must be current)
 - ii. Utility Bill
 - iii. Phone Bill (Not Cell Phone Bills)
 - iv. Property Tax Statement

*** The Sheriff's Office will not accept printed documents or copies. If you only get e-documents or on-line bills, go to the company or agency and have them provide a letter stating you have service at your address. They must also stamp the letter with their business stamp and initial it.*
